Tourniquets from a clinical and financial perspective

Due to the pressures on the NHS to reduce costs, tourniquets are often selected based on the lowest purchase price. This has led to tourniquets being purchased that in everyday use are found by many medical staff to be difficult to apply and uncomfortable for patients.

Many staff complain that rubber bands are difficult to apply/remove, pinch the patients skin and can create problems with patients with fragile skin and other skin conditions, leading to more staff returning to using fabric tourniquets, and using the same tourniquet on many different patients.

Tournistretch SP was developed for ease of use, patient comfort and and if introduced as a single in-patient stay* product can offer substantial cost savings:

Tournistretch SP is supplied with its own individual bag which can be written on or labelled with the patient's Name, Hospital Number and has a section with tick boxes to record each time the tourniquet is used. Tournistretch SP can be disinfected after use and placed in the individual patients resealable bag. In addition to meeting and exceeding the most rigorous infection control protocols, they are easy for medical staff to use and comfortable for patients.
